# BOWEL PREP INSTRUCTIONS SUTAB®

## THREE (3) DAYS BEFORE COLONOSCOPY

1. Avoid iron supplements, nuts, beans and raw fruits & vegetables (canned are okay).

4. At 5 p.m., open one bottle of 12 tablets. Fill the enclosed cup with 16 ounces of water (to the fill line). Swallow each tablet with a sip of water over a 15-to-20 minute. Drink all 16 ounces of water. At 6:30 p.m. drink another 16 ounces of water over the next 30 minutes. At 7:30 p.m. drink another 16 ounces of water over the next 30 minutes.		
DAY OF COLONOSCOPY		
<ul> <li>5. At (six hours before your procedure), open second bottle of 12 tablets. Again, swallow each tablet with a sip of water over a 15-to-20 minute period. Drink all 16 ounces of water.</li> <li>One hour after finishing the tablets, drink two 16oz cups of water over the next 60 min.</li> </ul>		
6. NOTHING BY MOUTH AFTER		
7. You should take morning medications. If you are already fasting, take them with a sip of water.

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## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

# Q. Do I have to take all of the prep even if my bowel movements look clear?

Yes! You must take all of the prep for a successful colonoscopy exam.

#### Q. How do I know if I'm cleaned out?

On the day of your colonoscopy, the nurse will ask you questions to confirm you're cleaned out. However, if you see brown, then the doctor sees brown. You will be cleaned out if:

- You DO NOT eat solid food.
- You DO push clear liquids all prep day.
- You DO drink all of your prep.

### Q. Will the bowel prep be painful?

No. However, the skin around your anus will get sore from the loose bowel movements. You can use Vaseline® or diaper rash ointment on your skin.

### Q. Will I get sick to my stomach?

Most people do not get sick. But if you do feel sick, stop taking the pills for 20 to 30 minutes, lie down and place a cool cloth on your forehead. Warm tea, flat soda and peppermints will also help. If you are unable to finish the prep, call your doctor's office.
